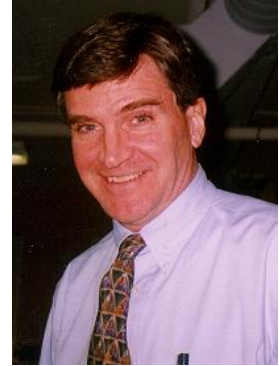




Randy Jones Award For Excellence in Airport Noise Mitigation

Introduction

The late Randolph Jones, AIA was known in the airport noise mitigation industry as a leader and innovator. Those that had the opportunity to interact with Randy knew him as a gentleman and gifted professional who helped shape the noise mitigation industry that exists today. The *Randy Jones Award for Excellence in Airport Noise Mitigation* annually recognizes an individual, airport or organization that has made a significant contribution to the industry.



Potential Nominees

The planning committee for the Airport Noise Mitigation Symposium is looking for individuals, airports, programs or organizations as potential candidates as the recipient for the annual 2011 award. Potential candidates could be individuals, airports and airport programs, government officials or organizations, consultants, product suppliers, contractors and homeowner organizations. Nominees should be focused primarily in the noise mitigation program industry working with sound insulation programs, land acquisition/resident relocation programs or other areas related to the implementation of noise compatibility programs.

Process

Anyone can nominate an individual, airport, program or organization for the award. Nominations for the annual 2011 award will be received by the Airport Noise Mitigation Symposium planning committee through July 1, 2011. A subcommittee will evaluate all of the nominees against the evaluation criteria and make a recommendation for the selection of the recipient for the 2011 award. The award for 2011 will be presented at the annual AAE Airport Noise Mitigation Symposium to be held in October in St. Louis.



Randy Jones Award For Excellence in Airport Noise Mitigation

Evaluation Criteria

The *Randy Jones Award for Excellence in Airport Noise Mitigation* is designed to recognize the efforts of an individual, airport, program or organization that has made a significant contribution to the airport noise mitigation industry that entails sound insulation programs, land acquisition/resident relocation programs, and/or other projects related to the implementation of noise compatibility programs. Nominees will be evaluated against the following criteria:

- Recognition as a leader in the airport noise mitigation industry.
- Employing innovative techniques in the solution of complex issues and problems.
- Reputation for enhancing the relationship between airports and the community.
- Contributor to the knowledge base of the industry.
- Developed tools or techniques that have furthered the industry and improved the effectiveness of noise mitigation programs.
- Dedicated to enhancing the quality of life for airport neighbors.

Nomination Criteria

Please provide a brief narrative statement describing this individual's, airport's or organization's contribution to the airport noise mitigation industry. Please feel free to submit any additional supporting documentation and use as many additional pages as necessary. A nomination form is included on page 3, but use of the form is not mandatory. Nomination can be made by mail, email or fax to the information provided at the bottom of page 3.

Nominators are requested to structure their submission around the award evaluation criteria including leadership, innovation and problem solving, reputation in developing community relations, contributions to the industry, etc. Please be explicit about what qualifies them for the nomination and the specific reasons why you are nominating this candidate.
